

ORDINANCE NO. 09-15

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR ON CERTAIN PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF ANDALE, KANSAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDALE, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. K.S.A. 41-719(c) provides that no person shall consume alcoholic liquor on public property, with certain exceptions. K.S.A. 41-719(d) provides that any city may exempt, by ordinance, from the provisions of K.S.A. 41-719(c) specified property the title of which is vested in such city. The City of Andale hereby elects to exempt certain public property from the provisions of K.S.A. 41-719(c) and to allow the consumption of alcoholic liquor on such public property.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 41-719(d) the City of Andale hereby exempts from the provisions of subsection (c) of K.S.A. 41-719 the following specified property, the title of which is vested in the City of Andale, and allows the consumption of alcoholic liquor on such property:

A) That area located in Block 12, City of Andale, Kansas, which is north of the north curb line of Anderson Avenue and south of a line located 160 feet north of the Anderson Avenue north curb line;

B) The remaining area located in Block 12, City of Andale, Kansas, but only with the prior approval of the governing body of the City of Andale, Kansas.

SECTION 3. All prior ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect after its publication once in the official city newspaper.
